CAMP 318 General Overview

DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES: For a full day of camp, the recommended drop off time is between 7:30-8:15 am and the recommended pick up time is between 5:00-5:30pm. If you would like to pick your child up early or drop them off late, please see Krystal Bell to make those arrangements. Otherwise, if you are late more than 5 minutes in picking up your camper, you will be charged a \$1 late fee each minute. Pick up and drop off will be located in "The Swamp" located near the second drive way. Each morning and afternoon, the person picking up or dropping off your child **will need to sign them in and out.**

PAYMENT: Payment for each week is due on or before the first day of each camp week. Failure to pay may result in the removal of the camper from camp. Parents are responsible for the entire session in which they register for.

EMERGENCY CARD/WAIVERS: Campers cannot attend camp until the parent/guardians has filled out the emergency information card, permission to treat form, and liability waiver. In addition, we also are asking you to fill out the permission slips regarding over the counter medication, biking/walking to camp, PG movies, and field trips. These forms are included in the packet.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP: Campers should bring clothes that may get wet/dirty and athletic shoes. **NO SANDLES/FLIP FLOPS.** If the camper does not have athletic shoes to wear they may not be able to participate in running activities and/or recess. It is also recommended that campers ages 4 and 5 bring with them a change of clothes and a mat and/or two towels for naps. Campers may bring with them appropriate toys/games to play with during free time at the counselor's discretion. Certain activities like some of the elective classes may require students to bring additional items with them to camp and will be communicated to you with an email, a note home, or text. To help your child keep track of her/his belongings, please label items with his/her name.

*Your child may bring these items every day:
(Don't forget to label all items with your child's name.)*

- Water bottle
- Book
- Electronic device
- Book bag or similar item that can be zipped or securely closed so items don't fall out.
- Peanut-free snacks (please provide food items that don't need to be refrigerated or reheated)

- Please send your child in wearing sneakers every day (much safer than flip flops or open-toe sandals)
- Sweatshirt/jacket (it can get chilly especially in the mornings)

Any toys or electronics brought to camp should be stored with the camp counselor until there is free or recreational time. Camp 318 is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

SNACKS/CONCESSION: Each camper may bring their own snacks from home. Concession will also be available to purchase. See a camp counselor for a complete list of concessions available.

FACILITIES: Camp 318 is located at St. Catherine's Community Center, 331 East 71st Street, Shreveport, LA 71106. Camp 318 will have access to six classrooms, bathrooms, and a gymnasium.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY: Camp 318 requires a two-week notice on any cancellations. In the event that a cancellation occurs with less than two-week notice, we will give you a rain check to be used on a future week this summer or the following summer. If payment has not yet been received at the time of the late cancellation, the family will still be required to pay for the registered weeks. This policy is to allow us adequate time to contact families with campers on the waiting list, and make informed decisions regarding weekly supplies and counselor work schedules.

Field Trip Days: Each camper will receive a camp shirt with a paid registration. For field trip days, all campers need to wear their camp t-shirt. We have extra camp shirts for \$12.
